Well well, our project uses machine learning and robotics expertise, we propose a 2-part solution to this problem: The first module is a free web application that takes a single input, the GPS location of any point in the world. Using a combination of geological features maps, satellite imagery, and Machine Learning, this web application will then predict the best places to drill a water well within walking distance. And we also thought about the countless people who don't have access to clean water and do not have access to a mobile phone or the internet. We added a second module to our project, which is a cheap portable device, costing under 10 USD. This device will store some precomputed ideal locations for wells from all around the world. It'll be able to detect the current GPS location of any user and guide them to the nearest ideal place to drill a water well. The scientific literature is full of examples of how machine learning can help predict Groundwater mapping potential, using information available on maps like the distance to the nearest river, the vegetation nearby, the soil composition, and so on. http://wellwell.app/

Station and Traffic Prediction of a Shared Bike System: A Case Study of Barcelona's Bicing

Bikes-Sharing Systems (BSS) are becoming an increasingly common means of transportation. Officials in most major cities are embracing them to reduce emissions, air pollution, improve traffic flow, and increase public health. A recurrent problem that users of BSS find is either no bikes in a station or no free slots to park. I gathered a dataset of Bicing (Barcelona's BSS) and performed several machine learning tasks. Amongst them are bike station clustering to find spatiotemporal patterns in bike use and traffic prediction to identify when a station is likely to run out of bikes or parking slots.






