Users can define the rules to block or activate some traffic sources by conditions to optimize the conversion and the budget. The second internal project was a recommendation service for creating prepared advertisement companies based on user perforations from exists list of campaigns of the user. The module automatically analyzes user companies and suggests basic configurations for the new one, including auditory and advertisement sources to maximize company income.



Well Well Well

800 million people in the world don't have access to clean water today. Some communities try to drill water wells, but they need help to know the best potential location before they start drilling. Why not use a little bit of AI to help them out?

We propose a 2 part solution to this problem:

- The first module is a free web application that takes a single input, the GPS location of any point in the world. This web application will then predict the best places to drill a water well within walking distance.
- The second module is for people who don't have access to a mobile phone. A cheap portable device (cost under 10 USD), that will store some precomputed ideal locations for wells all around the world and guide the user to the nearest place to drill a water well.
